

Cookies Policy

1. APPLICABLE RULES

The second section of article 22 of Law 34/2002 of July 11, Information Society and Electronic Commerce Services (hereinafter LSSI-CE), provides:

Service providers may use storage devices and data recovery in recipients' terminal equipments on condition that they have given their consent after they have been provided with clear and comprehensive information on their use, in particular on the purposes of data processing in accordance with the provisions of Law 15/1999, of December 13, Protection of Personal data with. Where technically possible and effective, the consent of the recipient to accept the data processing may be provided by using the appropriate settings of a browser or other applications, whenever he should proceed to its configuration during installation or update through an explicit action for such purpose.

The above does not prevent any storage or access of a technical nature for the sole purpose of carrying out a communication transmission by an electronic communications network or to the extent strictly necessary for the provision of a Information Society Service expressly requested by the recipient.

As recorded by the "Guidelines on the use of cookies", published by the Spanish Data Protection Agency (hereinafter AEPD) in 2013, the LSSI-CE is applicable to any type of file or device downloaded to a user's terminal equipment in order to store data that can be updated and retrieved by the entity responsible for its installation. The cookie is one of those devices of widespread use, so henceforth we will generically refer to these devices as cookies.

Excluded from compliance with the obligations under Article 22.2 of the LSSI-CE are cookies used for any of the following purposes:

- Allow communication only between the user equipment and the network.
- Strictly provide a service explicitly requested by the user.

2. TYPES OF COOKIES ACCORDING TO THEIR PURPOSE

A cookie is a file that is downloaded to your computer when accessing certain web pages. Cookies allow a website, among other things, store and retrieve information about a user or his computer browsing habits and, depending on the information they contain and the way he uses his computer, can be used to recognize the user.

As reflected in the AEPD "Guide on the use of cookies", according to the purpose for which the data obtained through the cookies are processed, we can distinguish between:

- **Technical Cookies:** are those that allow the user to navigate through a website, platform or application and use the different options or services available as, for example, traffic and data communication control, identify the session, access parts of restricted access, remember the elements of an order, make the buying process of an order, make the request for registration or participation in an event, use security features while browsing, store content for video or sound broadcast or share content via social networks.
- **Customization Cookies:** are those that allow the user to access the service with some general nature features predefined depending on a number of criteria in the user terminal such as would be the language, type of browser through which access to service, regional settings from which accessing the service, etc.
- **Analysis cookies:** are those that allow the responsible for them, monitoring and analyzing the user's behaviour of the websites to which they are linked. The information gathered through such cookies is used in measuring the web, application or platform sites activity and to create navigation profiles of the users of such sites, applications and platforms, in order to make improvements based on analysis of usage data made by the service users.

- Advertising Cookies: These are those that enable the management, as efficiently as possible, of advertising spaces that, where appropriate, the editor has included on a website, application or platform from which providing the requested service based on criteria such as the edited content or the frequency in which ads are displayed.
- Behavioural advertising cookies: are those that allow the management as efficiently as possible, of advertising spaces that, where appropriate, the editor has included on a website, application or platform from which providing the requested service. These cookies store information on user behaviour obtained through continued observing their browsing habits, allowing developing a specific profile to display ads based on it.

3. INFORMATION PRINCIPLE

In compliance with the provisions of Article 5 of Law 15/1999, of December 13, Protection of Personal Data (hereinafter Act), we inform you explicitly, precisely and unequivocally that the information obtained through cookies to be installed on your computer will be used for the following purposes: to ensure the quality, safety and improvement of the offered services.

The recipients of the information obtained through cookies to be installed on your computer will be the following entities:

- The editor responsible for the website and the data controller: AINIA
Where appropriate, the entities directly related to the editor responsible for the website that is explicitly related below: GOOGLE INC.

4. CONSENT PRINCIPLE

Consent for installation of cookies will be understood as provided by marking the box on the acceptance of "cookies policy" provided for this purpose on our website.

In cases where the user does not explicitly state whether or not to accept the installation of cookies, but continue to use the website or the application it will be deemed that it has given its consent, explicitly informing our organization about the possibility to block or remove cookies installed on his computer by configuring the browser options installed on his computer.

5. OPTIONAL BASIS OF COOKIES INSTALLATION

While accepting the installation of cookies on your computer is optional for you, refusal to installation can assume that the functionality of the website remain limited or not possible, which would make it impossible the provision of services by our entity through it.

6. DEACTIVATION OF COOKIES

The user may at any time change the cookies settings, block or disable them. To do this we provide the way in major browsers.

8. EXERCISE OF RIGHTS

In compliance with the LOPD and Royal Decree 1720/2007, of 21 December, approving the regulation developing it, the service recipient can exercise at any time, their rights of access, rectification, cancellation and opposition with regards to the data controller, enclosing a photocopy of his ID card.
